Columbiana County Port Authority Wellsville Intermodal Facility



The Columbiana County Port Authority's Wellsville Intermodal Facility, located at Mile Post 48 on the northernmost point of the Ohio River in Wellsville, Ohio, is in the geographic center of five of the six largest population markets in the USA, excluding LA (NYC; Chicago; Atlanta; Philadelphia/Baltimore/DC; and Cleveland/Pittsburgh). Direct highway ramp access to SR 7 connects 40 miles north and south, respectively, to I-70 and I-76/80 via SR 7 and SR 11.

The Intermodal Facility's 60-ton top running Virginia Overhead Bridge Crane, 800-ton Mantsinen 120 HybriLift material handler, and 48-in. Imperial Technology conveyor system, is equipped to handle container, break bulk and bulk cargos off the Ohio River to truck or rail car service with Norfolk Southern for final destination. International cargo access is also accessible via the Mississippi River to New Orleans and Ten-Tom Waterway to Mobile. On site transloading is managed and provided by Pier 48 Stevedoring, LLC, Larry Heck, President.

The Columbiana County Port Authority has broad powers to: Own, lease, sell and construct improvements to real estate property; Receive State and Federal Grants and Loans; Establish Bond Funds; Exercise Powers on Behalf of Another Subdivision; Receive Federal and State Tax Exemption; Issue Revenue Bonds; and, May Maintain Confidentiality of Private Businesses.
